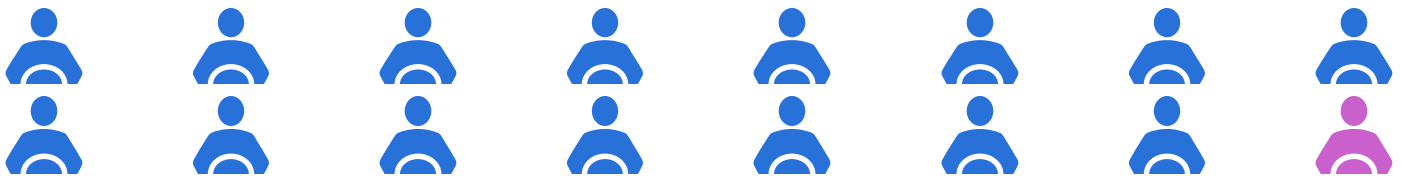

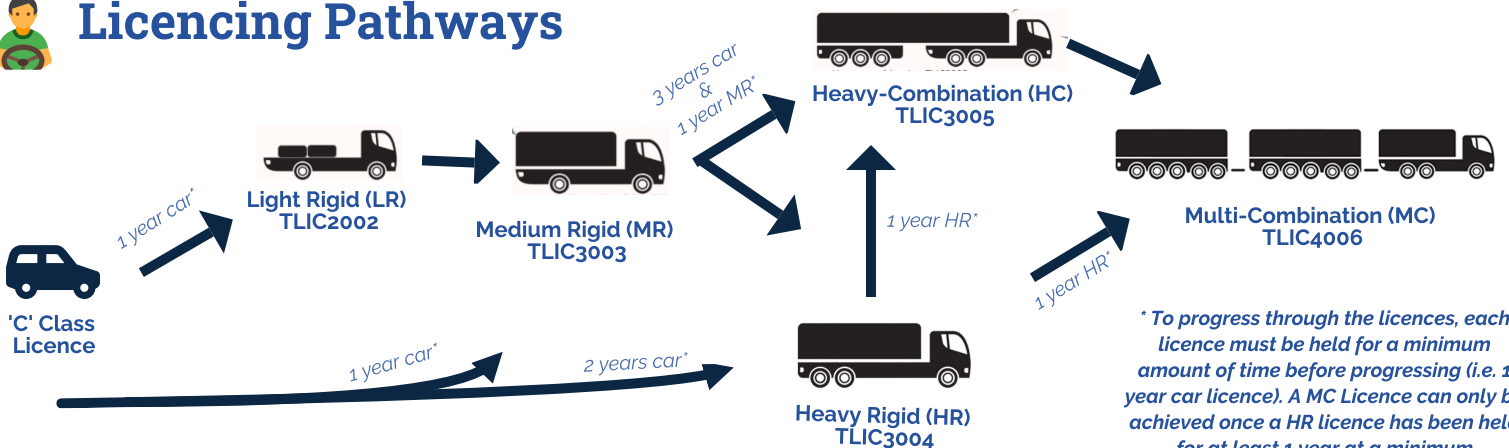
businesses nationally comprising large, medium and smaller owner/operator companies.
