Key Skills

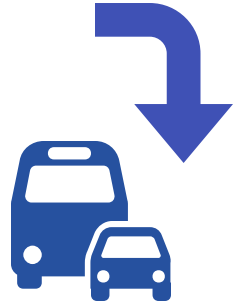
- Most roles require a licencing component (i.e. HR for bus drivers etc).

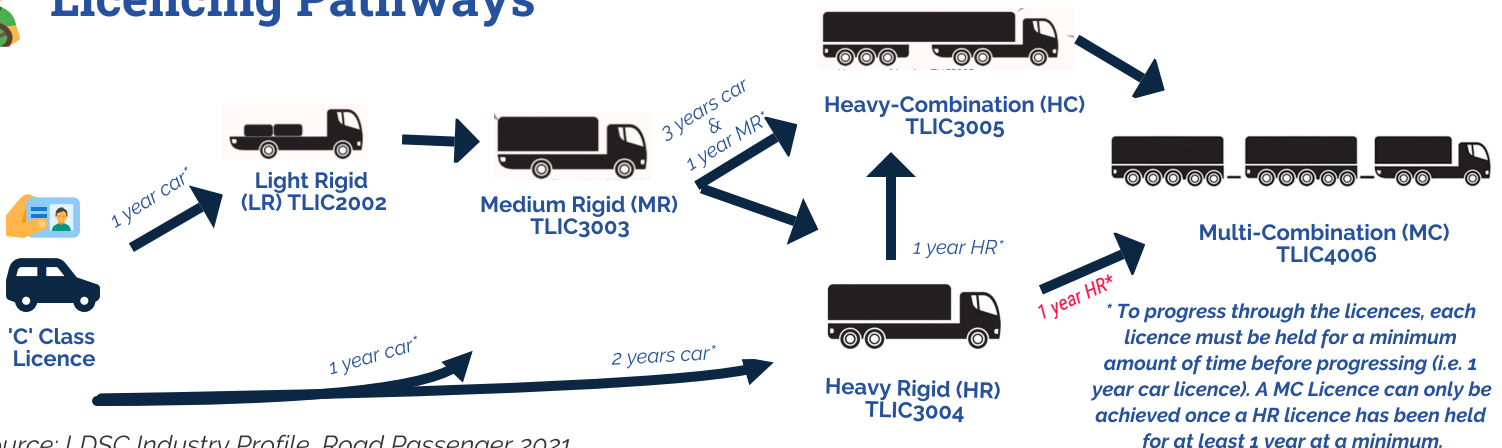
locations are serviced on the regional network of TransWA by road coach.
