

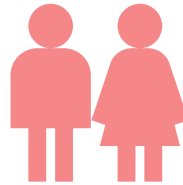

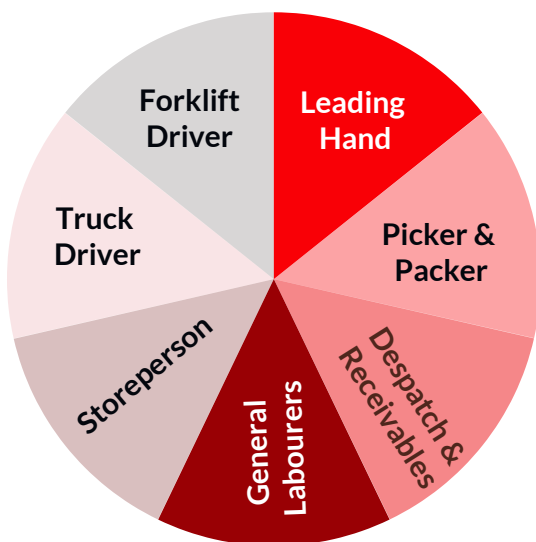
warehousing businesses operate nationally, with a market size of approximately \$5.3 Billion due to expanding international trade.

## Rise in Value Added Services

- new technology and home delivery services becoming available.

## Rise in Online Shopping

Demand from online shopping is expected to rise strongly in 2020 to 21 representing an opportunity for industry revenue expansion.

Demand from third-party storage is expected to increase in 2020 to 21 due to online retailers requiring more storage of goods before they are sold, or delivered to the customer.
