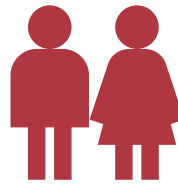


The Wholesale trade consists of enterprises engaged in the buying and on-selling of goods to other businesses and in some cases the public. Wholesalers also engage in buying and selling goods. Wholesalers generally operate from warehouses and transact only with other businesses.

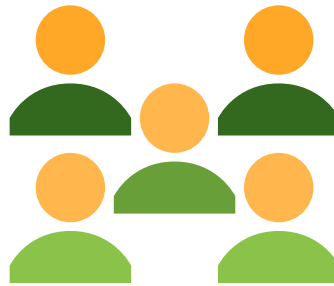

Storepersons and General Sales Assistants are the most common occupations within the Wholesale Trade industry, accounting for more than 2% and 12% respectively of the national workforce.

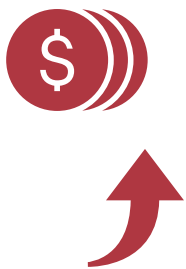

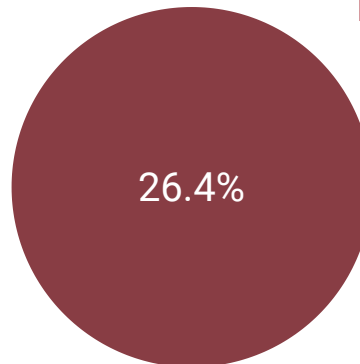

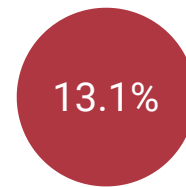

is the sector revenue for Wholesale Trade making it the 14th fastest growing sector in Australia over the past five years.

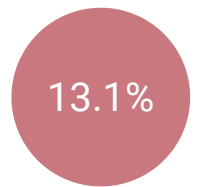
